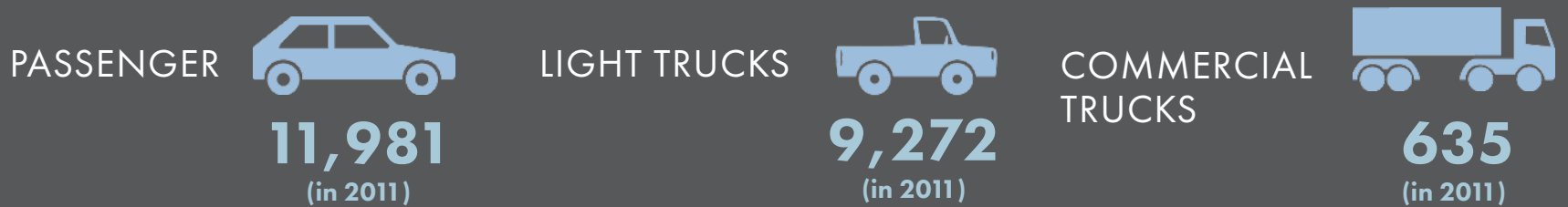

TRUCK CRASH



INVESTIGATION/DATA

- Car crash evidence, plus:
 - Driver evidence: qualifications and training, criminal history, log books, post-collision drug and alcohol tests, payroll history
 - Vehicle evidence: black box/usage data, maintenance history, inspection history, GPS data
 - Cargo evidence: weight tickets, trip envelopes, delivery documents, bills of lading

- Truck driver, trucking company, broker, dispatcher, trailer owner, maintenance company, shipper/loader

- Federal and state commercial trucking regulations dictate inspection and maintenance procedures, operation procedure and hours of operation
