

Your Rights and Responsibilities Under Missouri Workers' Compensation Law

Workers' Compensation is a form of insurance that is guaranteed to all employees of businesses with more than five employees and all construction workers regardless of the size of the company. It provides wage replacement and medical benefits to workers who are injured on the job.

Under Missouri Workers' Compensation Law, if you're hurt on the job, you have the right to:

Treatment

Have your medical treatment provided;



Portion of wages

A portion of your wages while you are off work recovering from, or receiving treatment for, your injuries;



Payments

A lump sum payment for disability, or weekly payments if you are permanently totally disabled.



Under Missouri Workers' Compensation Law, if you're hurt on the job, you're responsible for:



INFORMING EMPLOYER

Informing your employer promptly following a work accident that resulted in injury;



SEEING A DOCTOR

Seeing the doctor or medical professional that is recommended by your employer;



WORKING ON RESTRICTED DUTY

Working on restricted duty if the doctor recommends it and the work is available within your restrictions.
