

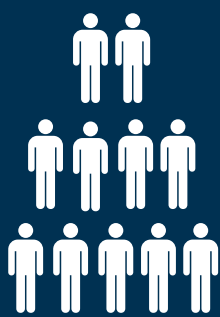


TRUCK ACCIDENTS

On average, truck accidents kill 11 people every day and injure more than **100,000** people each year.



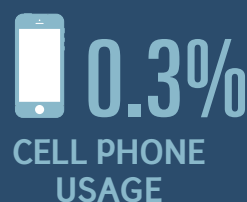
Truck accidents cause as many deaths as if a commuter **jet** crashed every week of the year, killing everyone on board.
